They last two to three times longer than conventional hardened knives, and technicians can expect to spend less time performing maintenance with bedknife-to-reel adjustments, backlapping, grinding, and changing bedknives during the growing season.

The hardened low-cut knives are less aggressive than conventional heat-treated low-cut knives by approximately 2 mm (0.079-in.), reducing the impact to the grass plant, reducing lines and signs of stress, and leaving an optimum after-cut appearance.

Recommended when installing 14-blade reels. Compatible with Quick-Adjust (QA5) cutting units and 180SL and 220SL PrecisionCut™ walk greens mowers.
